

General safety and procedural rules

All Drivers must be of age 12-16 to participate in the demolition derby for youth classes. Youth drivers must show proof of age for first time running one of our shows(maple festival, troy fair, tioga county fair) Also must have a completed and Notarized waiver for each show.

All other classes ages are 16.5 with drivers license and up. Valid Id must be shown

Windshield safety straps are mandatory for every class. Please see each class for rules per that class for mounting.

Safety gear: Long pants, closed toe shoes or boots , eye protection and a DOT/SNELL approved $\frac{3}{4}$ face or full face helmet is required for competition. If any of these items are removed during competition you will be DQ!!

Neck brace, long sleeve shirt, FR coat or shirt and gloves are strongly encouraged!!!

Any marine or boat tank MUST be securely fastened we suggest a metal frame or base for it that can be securely mounted to the floor and tank securely mounted to it. If any official deems it unsafe it will need to be fixed or you will be DQ!

Tow Vehicles and trailers ONLY in the pits. NO alcohol or controlled substances allowed on premises. Pit speed is under 5MPH(just over an idle) Golf carts only may be used to travel from pits to track side. The speed limit is the same. Please do not abuse this. Pit age is 12+

Driver ONLY in inspection and drivers meeting(exception youth classes a parent or guardian may accompany the youth driver) Once you have passed inspection you cannot go back to your trailer with your vehicle. You must exit the inspection and pit area and finish closing your hood in line up.

After competition all vehicles must be towed from the track to the Pits...this is non negotiable!

NO FIGHTING or ARGUING will be TOLERATED! There Will be strict consequences for those involved from show suspension to expulsion. If a physical altercation takes place those involved may also face penalties and fines subject to the court of law.

Vehicle builds are per class and the rules must be followed all 3 shows run the same rules so you all have multiple chances to run the vehicles with the same rule set. VEHICLE MUST BE STOCK OTHER THAN THE LISTED MODIFICATIONS PER CLASS. NOTHING ELSE

Any situations that come up the promoters have the power to add or change rules required (2025-2028). Just because it isn't in the rules, it doesn't make it legal. All vehicles are to remain factory other than the modifications allowed and spelled out in each particular section. NOTHING MORE!!! Anything found to be Illegal before and after the show can result in Disqualification from the event and forfeiture or the winnings.
